


PURPOSE: The purpose of this procedure is to demonstrate clean and reset the filters for Smartboard projector NEC NP610S.



OPERATING SYSTEM: Windows 7 is demonstrated in this procedure, but similar steps can be taken with Windows XP and Vista.

PROCESS STEP	REFERENCE IMAGE	
<p>STEP 1: Locate filter location on the rear of the projector.</p>		
	<p>Remove filter by pressing the tab located on the top of the filter frame.</p>	
<p>STEP 2: Locate filter location on the side of the projector.</p>	<p>Remove filter by pressing the tab located on the top of the filter frame.</p>
